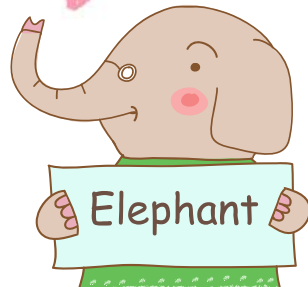

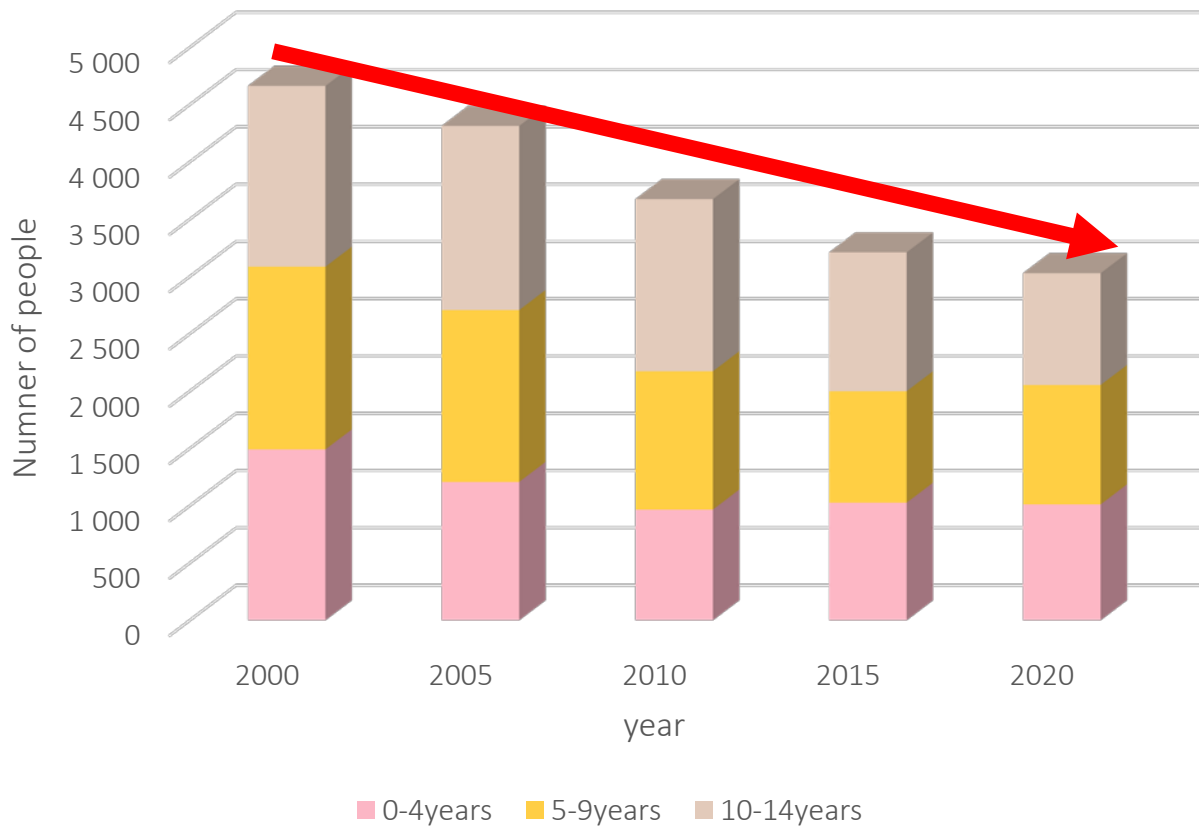

China	10

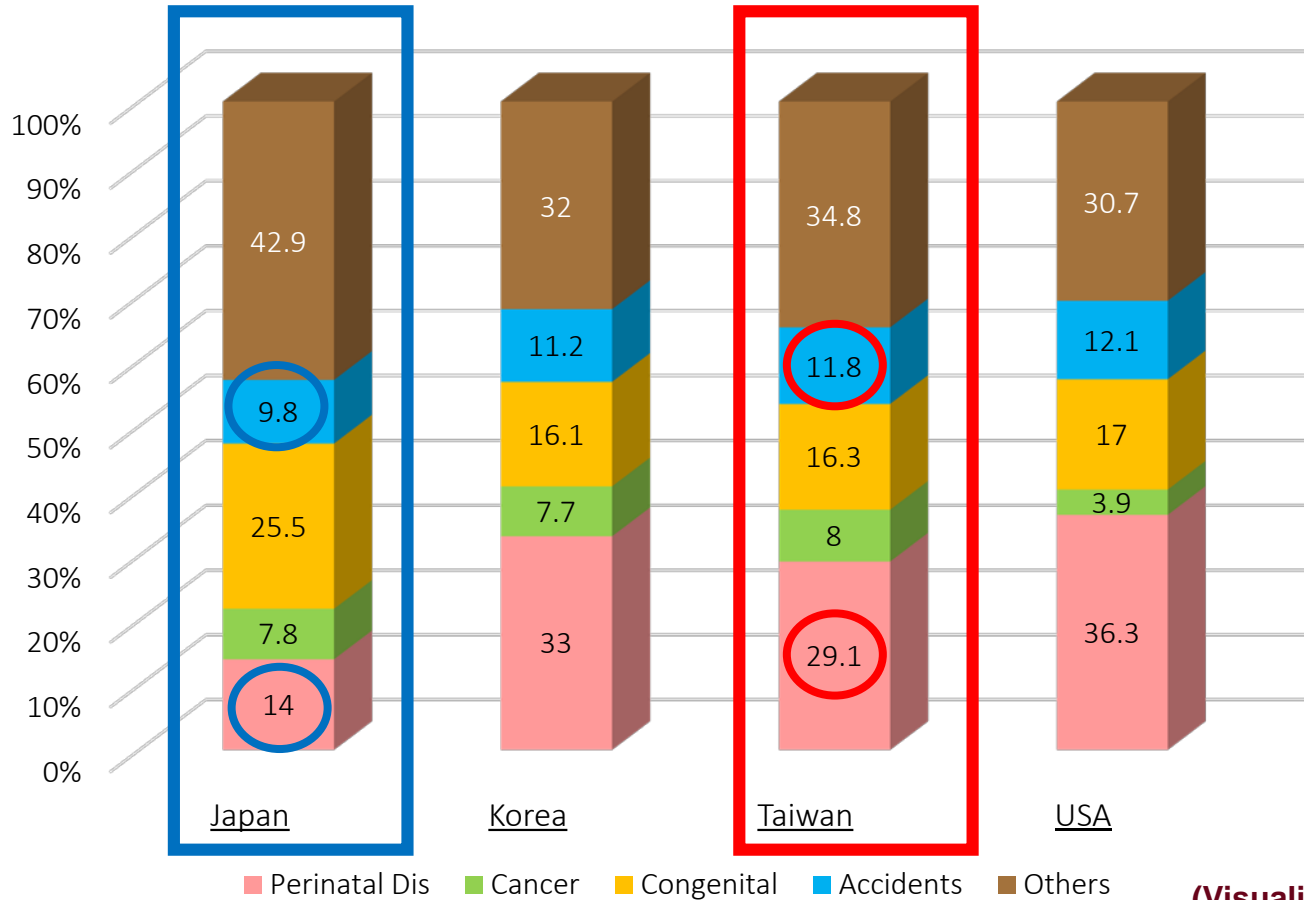
Mortality rate: dead birth per thousand infants

Causes of death

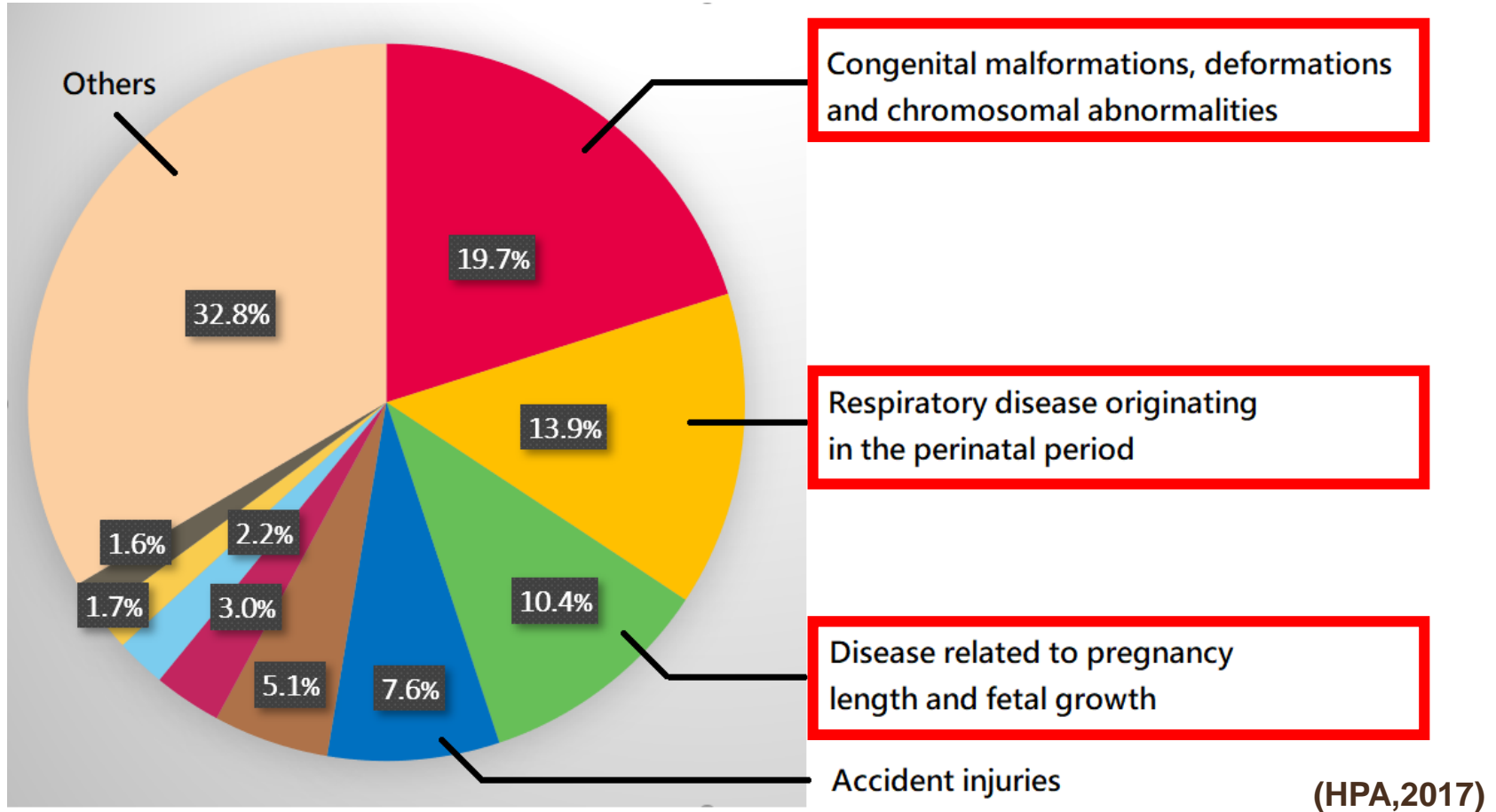


≤14 years old people (Among four countries)

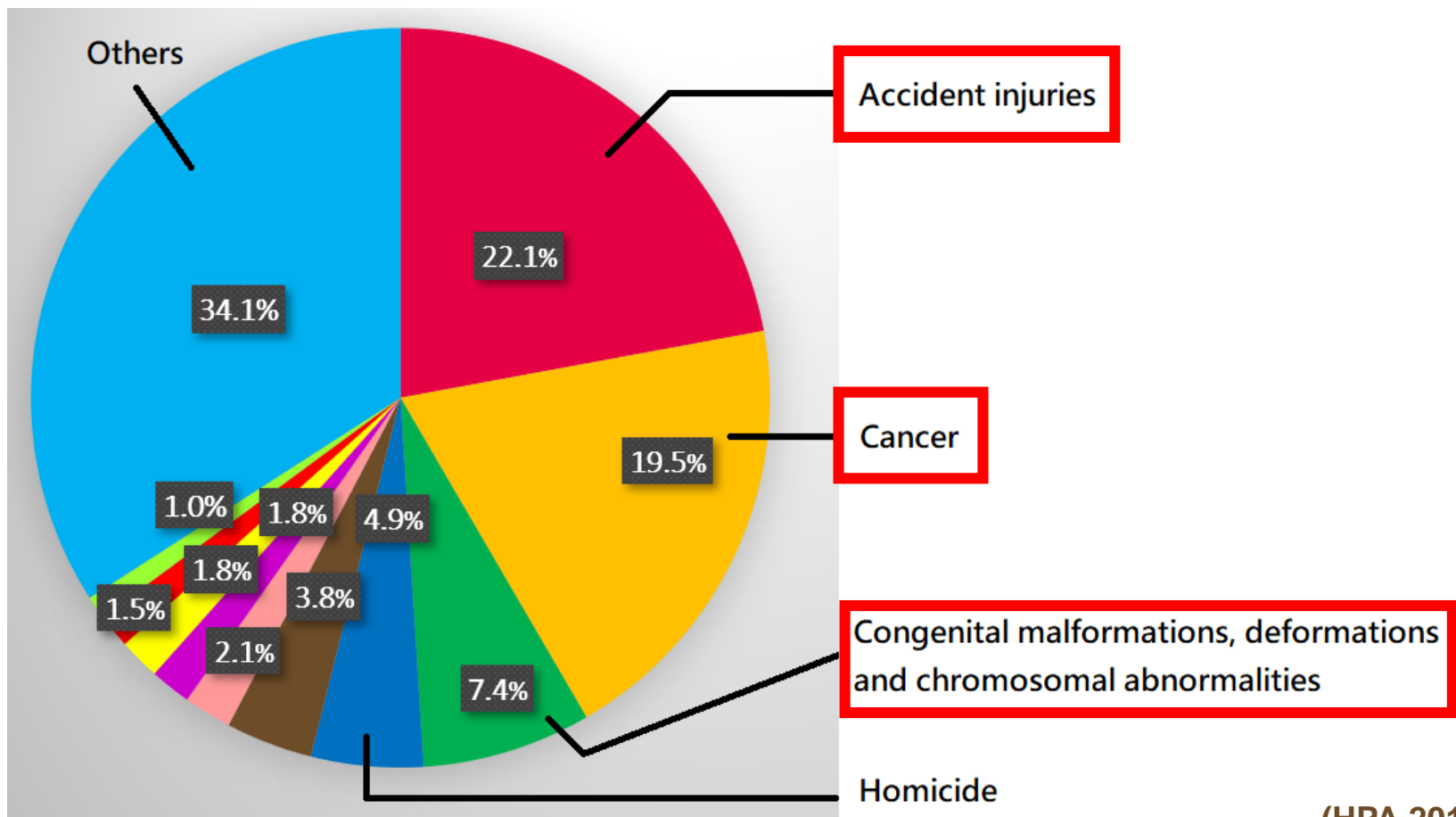

one of the best in the world.

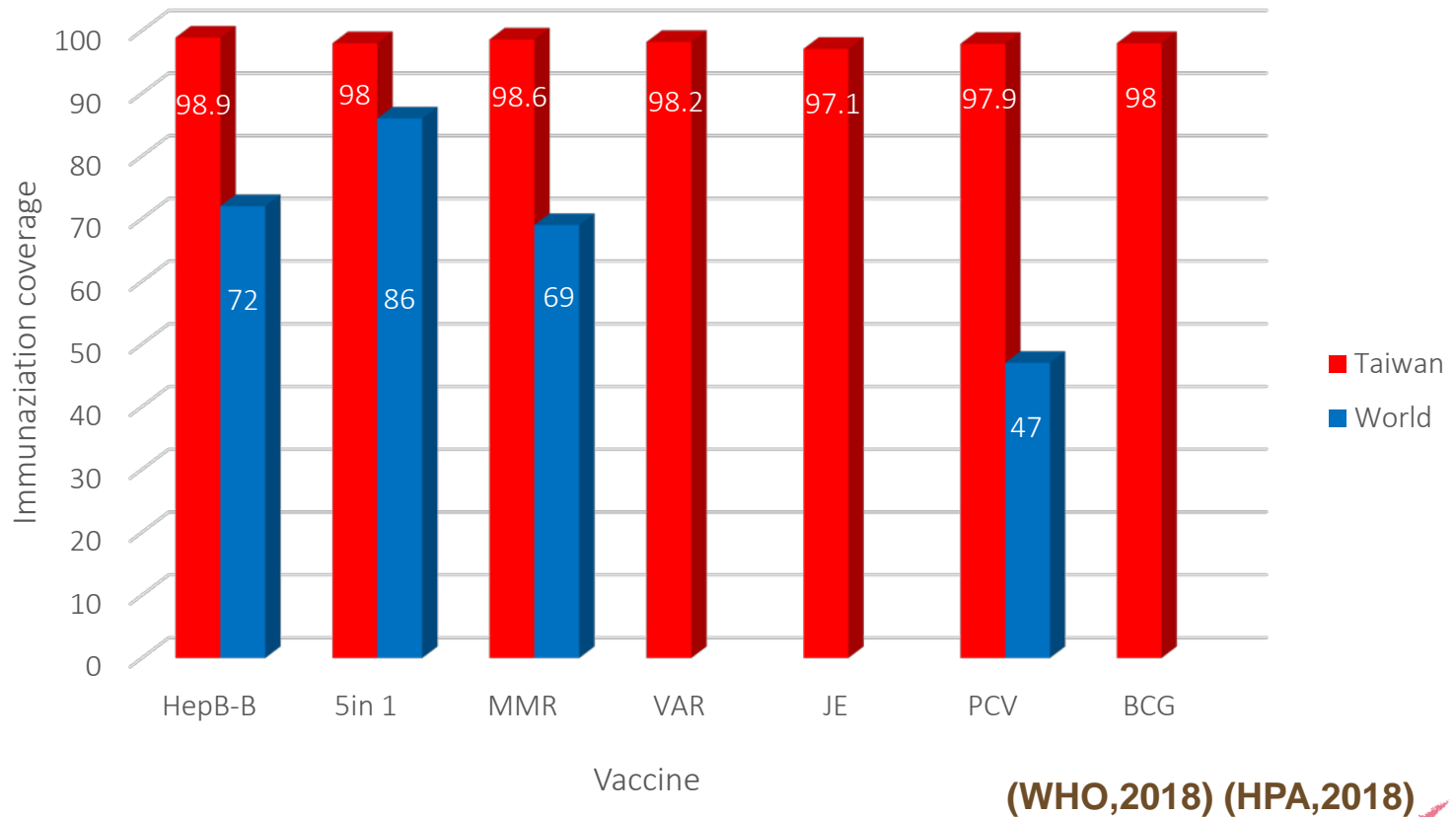
